### VOLUNTEER TUTOR JOB DESCRIPTION

#### Position

• Volunteer Tutor / Adult Literacy Partner

#### Purpose

- To help an individual with reading, writing, math, science, social studies, or computer literacy in order to obtain a GED or prepare for college level classes.
- To help an individual learn to read, write, understand and speak English, or gain citizenship.

#### Qualifications

- Able to give one or more hours a week in volunteer time;
- Good verbal and listening skills;
- Ability to work with diverse group of students (ages, ethnic backgrounds, literacy levels);
- Respect for confidentiality;
- Literate, empathetic, respectful, dependable, patient, flexible, and optimistic;
- Must pass a background check;
- Teaching/tutoring experience preferred.

#### Place of Work

- Meeting locations are flexible, however, volunteers are strongly encouraged to use SERRC/TLC facilities and materials.
- When SERRC/TLC facilities are closed, tutors and students should meet in a public facility such as the library.

#### Hours

- The length of tutoring sessions is flexible.
- Volunteers should consider at least one hour each week for preparation.

#### Responsibilities

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- Meet with student partner weekly for tutoring lessons
- · Report both your and your student's hours
- Attend tutor orientation and recognition ceremonies
- Confer with Volunteer Literacy Coordinator for instructional guidance and support

#### **Background Check Disclosure**

In order to qualify as a potential volunteer with SERRC, all volunteers must pass a background check. SERRC will obtain reports that detail any criminal history information and motor vehicle driving record for each volunteer applicant. This information will be kept in a confidential locked location separate from the volunteer's application. Background check information will <u>only</u> be used to screen volunteers. This information will not be released to others, including other staff and volunteers.

Failure to provide this information will result in the denial of any volunteer opportunities with SERRC.
