

**Participant Eligibility
For SERRC/The Learning Connection's
STEP Program
2017 / 2018**

Individuals are eligible if they have worked in a position covered by unemployment insurance within the last 5 years and need skills to increase their employment outlook.

To be accepted into the program, participants must meet **all** of these criteria:

- be a resident of Alaska as defined in 8 AAC 87.040, Residency; **and**
- have worked in a position covered by unemployment insurance (defined in AS 23.20, or similar provisions in another state) at any time during the previous five years; **and**
- need training to improve your prospects for getting or keeping employment.

Participants must also meet **one** of these criteria:

- be employable but not currently employed; **and**
 - receiving unemployment insurance benefits; **or**
 - has exhausted the right to unemployment insurance benefits within the past three years; **or**
- be employed, but liable to be displaced because of:
 - reductions in overall employment within a business; **or**
 - elimination of the worker's current job; **or**
 - change in conditions of employment requiring that, to remain employed, the employee must learn substantially different skills that the employee does not now possess.
